For the week of October 28 – November 3

Prayer: That we may fully embrace God's salvific work as we await his coming.

Day 1: Psalm 130

Two questions to ponder:

- Do we worry about our list of iniquities?
- The psalmist "waits for the Lord." What is he waiting for?

Day 2: Amos 2:6 - 16 & Isaiah 44:9-20

Three questions to ponder:

- What types of sins are on God's list of iniquities?
- Why do these actions bother God?
- What is the result of not turning to God and repenting?

Day 3: Hosea 11

Three questions to ponder:

- What is God's posture toward his people?
- What is the people's posture in this passage toward God?
- What does God promise his people?

Day 4: Luke 7:36 - 50

Three questions to ponder:

- What does Jesus want us to learn from his story?
- What are some differences between the sinful woman and Simon the Pharisee?
- What is the response to forgiveness, according to Jesus?

Day 5: Psalm 130

Three questions to ponder:

- How could the psalmist relate to others we have read about?
- What do you imagine the response of the psalmist is to God's forgiveness?
- V. 3 Why can we "stand?"

Further Reflection : How much have we been forgiven? How do we think God thinks about us (consider the Hosea and Luke passages)? In what ways are we waiting, like the psalmist in Psalm 130?
