

The Lord told Noah to build Him an arky, arky
For the week of June 2 – 8

Big Question for the week: What vital aspect of Christian life or trust do we discover in this 'kids story'?

Day 1: Genesis 6:1 – 8 (skim Genesis 1 – 2)

Three questions to ponder:

- What is confusing? What is clear? What is surprising?
- Where do you hear echoes of the creation story?
- What do we learn about Noah from these verses that would make him favorable to God? What makes this significant?

Day 2: Genesis 6:9 – 22

Two questions to ponder:

- Verse 9 marks the transition to a new 'era'.
- What do we learn about Noah and his family? What do we 're-learn' about the world? And about how God sees?
- What is God's desired action through the flood?

Day 3: Genesis 7:1 – 24

Three questions to ponder:

- What echoes of creation language do you hear?
- What do we see Noah do? What do we see God do?
- What is the tone of verse 22 – 24?

Day 4: Genesis 8:1 – 22

Four questions to ponder:

- Given the way Genesis 7 ends, how does verse 1 read?
- What are the points of significance from the chapter?
- Where do we hear echoes of creation?
- What promises does God make in response to Noah?

Day 5: Genesis 9:1 – 17

Three questions to ponder:

- How do the verse 1 – 7 connect to the previous three chapters? To the creation account?
- What does God do in this chapter? What does Noah do?
- How does memory (God's memory) impact our life today?

Prayer: we might find greater hope and trust in the LORD God.
