For the week of July 7 – 13

**Big Question for the week:** What vital aspect of Christian life or trust do we discover in this 'kids story'?

### **Day 1: Genesis 37:1 – 36**

Four questions to ponder:

What threatens to disrupt God's promises in the text?

What threatens to undo or disrupt God's promises in your life? How have you worked through that?

How does God promise to be actively involved?

### **Day 2: Genesis 39:1 – 23**

Three questions to ponder:

What threatens to disrupt God's promises in this text?

Where is God in this text?

When has God been 'with you' in a way similar to how He was with Joseph?

### **Day 3: Genesis 41:1 – 49**

Four questions to ponder:

What threatens to disrupt God's promises in this text?

Where is God in this text?

How are we clued into God's intervention in the life of Joseph? (clue: wonder about the number of dreams)

How are we clued into God's providence today?

### **Day 4: Genesis 42:1 – 38**

Two questions to ponder:

What threatens to disrupt God's promises in this text?

Where is God in this text?

### **Day 5: Genesis 44:1 – 45:8**

Three questions to ponder:

What threatens to disrupt God's promises in this text?

Where is God in this text?

When have you been able to reflect and see how God used pain and suffering to positively shape you?

**Prayer: we might find greater hope and trust in the LORD God.**
