For the week of July 14 – 20

Big Question for the week: What vital aspect of Christian life or trust do we discover in this 'kids story'?

Day 1: Joshua 4:15 – 5:12

Three questions to ponder:

- How does God prepare His people for the conquest of Canaan?
- What do these verses reveal about Israel as a people that are surprising?
- What lessons / truths might we glean from these verses?

Day 2: Joshua 2:1 – 14, 6:22 – 25

Three questions to ponder:

- What significance does Rahab have in the events of the conquest? And in God's greater plan of redemption?
- What do you think the other Israelites thought about Rahab and her family?
- How does Rahab demonstrate God's mercy and justice?

Day 3: Joshua 5:13 – 6:27

Three questions to ponder:

- What do we learn of Joshua in this chapter?
- What do we learn of Israel?
- What do we learn about God?

Day 4: Joshua 7:1 – 8:2

Two questions to ponder:

- What do we learn about the constant threat of disobedience? Of temptation?
- Is God unreasonable in v.12? Why or why not?

Day 5: Romans 8:28 – 39

Three questions to ponder:

- How is the conquest language in Joshua used by Paul?
- How is our conquest different in Christ Jesus?
- When can you testify to God's *being for you*?

Prayer: we might find greater hope and trust in the LORD God.
