Day 4: Luke 18:18 – 30

Four questions to ponder:

- How is this passage connected to the story of Zacchaeus?
- How is Zacchaeus like the rich young ruler?
- How is Zacchaeus unlike the rich young ruler?
- What impossible transformation have you witnessed?

Day 5: Luke 5:27 – 32

Three questions to ponder:

- How do we see the crowd respond?
- How does Jesus lay out His ministry plan?
- How does this include someone like Zacchaeus?
